



## Louisiana Alpha Delta Kappa 2022-2024 Biennium Report Immediate Past State President

Thank you to the members of Louisiana Alpha Delta Kappa for the honor of serving as your Immediate Past President this biennium. Serving in this role has given me the opportunity to learn new skills and to meet and work with new sisters, chapter officers and to renew bonds and memories with other sisters in Louisiana, the Gulf, as well as Internationally.

During this biennium, I attended all of the executive board meetings. I attended the Gulf Regional Conference in Florida where I served as the Regional Co-Chaplain and helped organize and execute the Gulf Omega service. At the Gulf Conference I attended meetings with the President, President-Elect, and VP of Membership. We met with members of the International Executive Board to get updates on changes happening at the Gulf and International levels.

I also attended the International Convention in Kansas City, Missouri.
