The Louisiana Guidelines for the Fraternity Education Committee are stated in the Alpha Delta Kappa Sorority Policy and Procedure Handbook as the following:

- The Fraternity Education Chairman shall carry out Fraternity Education programs as requested by the state president.
- The Fraternity Education Chairman may work with chapter Fraternity Education Committee chairmen, to ensure the planning of Fraternity Education Programs at each meeting.
- The Fraternity Education Committee should plan a fraternity education program for the state convention.

To meet these guidelines, this committee has accomplished the following:

- This committee has published chapter anniversaries in the monthly state newsletter monthly from May 2022 – and will continue until April 2024.

This committee has also published the individual membership anniversaries in the newsletter annually (May – December 2022, January –December 2023, and January – March 2024)

for Violets (10th year), Silver (25th year), Sapphire (40th year), Golden (50th year) and Diamond (60th year).

- This committee has provided information in the monthly state newsletter for the following topics as requested by the state president as suggestions for future chapter

fraternity education activities for a leadership report and to put in the state newsletter.

- Spend time sharing information about the sorority's history and founders, and spend time with fun "ice breaker" activities getting to really know your chapter members.
- Share with chapter members the current changes that have occurred in the sorority that will improved our objectives and are meant to encourage our membership with younger sisters.

Suggestions: Getting to know your membership, ask questions that will let you know the fun activities and interests they enjoy most, such as, travel: countries they would like to

visit in the future or help them make a "Bucket List". There are many You Tube videos giving grand tours of the place or country and information on how to plan an affordable vacation.

Have a Game Night – Bring games they have mentioned. Play some of the suggested games in groups and also in pairs. Door prizes for winners are always fun, too.

- The committee has published contact information regarding the chairman and committee members for fraternity education for chapters to contact in all state newsletters.
- To meet the third state guideline for this committee, the fraternity education committee, along with a few members of LA Beta Eta, is planning a fraternity education presentation at the state

Convention on March 9, 2024. The theme of this presentation will be "Sharing the history of Louisiana's Past State Presidents from 1953 to the Present". There will be a Power Point Presentation with information gathered from the state past state presidents' scrapbook about each president. Louisiana has had thirty-five Louisiana sisters to serve as state president for the last sixty-eight years. Louisiana currently has thirteen living past presidents. This is a great accomplishment for a state and these members have continued to be active in our state membership.
