

Louisiana's Altruistic Focus - Fostering Awareness

Foster Care statistics:

- An average of 4,100 children are currently in foster care in Louisiana.
- There are approximately 1,700 certified foster families in Louisiana.
- The goal of 67% of cases is reunification with the parents/caregivers.
- 29% of case plan goals include adoption.
- Only 50% of foster children complete high school.
- Over 40% of foster children experience educational difficulties.
