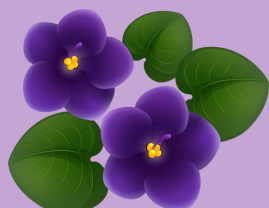
Hello Sisters,

On the website first find the Alpha Delta Kappa Global Team, and then create your Chapter's team. Please include LA in your team's name (LA Beta Eta).

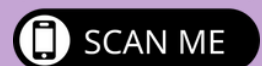
When registering your team use the promo code FIGHT to waive the \$20 registration fee.
